How are we determine proficiency in our faculty? Degrees? Native speaking skills?

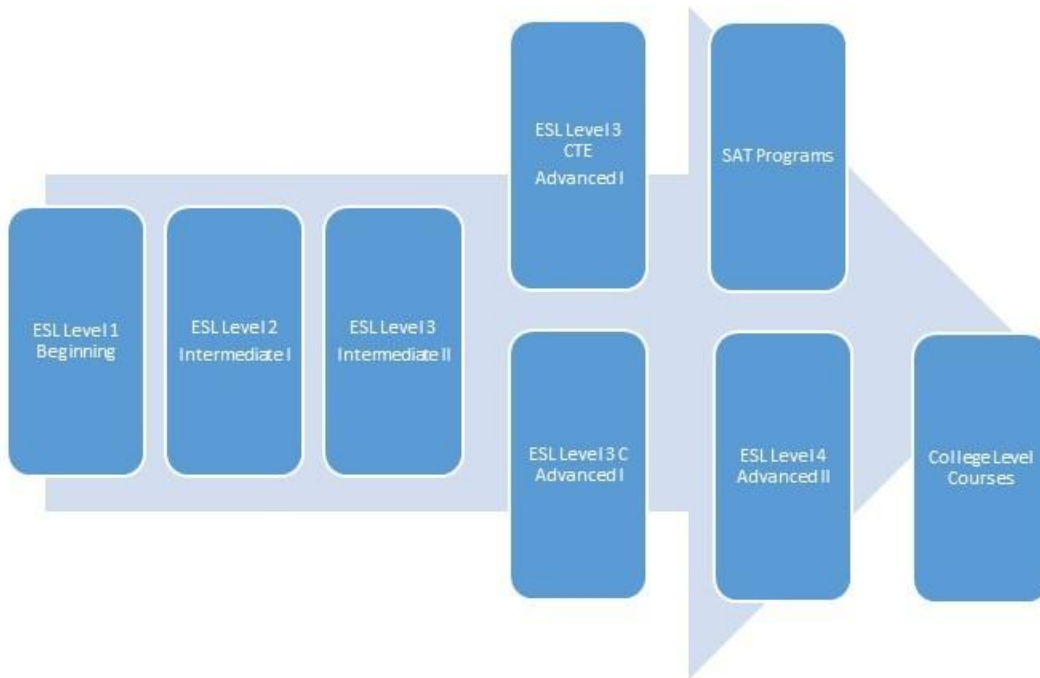
Mission: We have two different but related mission statements:
